



## Recommended Equipment List for Yukon Hunts

### Horse Hunts:

75 pounds maximum

- compact sleeping bag (10 below)
- light sleeping pad (optional)
- long johns (2 pair)
- warm socks (4 pair)
- warm shirts
- warm vest
- wool pants (1 pair)
- jeans (1 pair)
- water resistant boots
- light pair of camp shoes
- warm coat (3/4 length)
- warm gloves (2 pair)
- warm pullover hat
- any other hat of preference
- rain coat (not rubber lined)
- rain pants
- bug dope
- personal gear (towel, toothbrush, etc.)
- soft rifle or bow case

### Back Pack Hunts:

45 pounds maximum

- compact sleeping bag (10 below)
- light sleeping pad (foamic)
- long johns (1 pair)
- warm socks (3 pair)
- warm shirts (2 pair)
- warm pants (1 pair)
- jeans (1 pair)
- good hiking boots
- warm gloves (2 pair)
- warm pullover hat
- rain gear (not rubber lined)
- water jug (1 pint)
- bug dope
- personal gear (towel, toothbrush, small first aid kit, etc.)
- bic lighters (2)
- soft rifle or bow case

### Boat Hunts:

75 pounds maximum

- compact sleeping bag (10 below)
- light sleeping pad (optional)
- long johns (2 pair)
- warm socks (4 pair)
- warm shirts
- warm pants (2 pair)
- jeans (1 pair)
- waterproof boots (rubber bottoms)
- light pair of camp shoes
- insulated coat
- insulated coveralls
- warm gloves (2 pair)
- warm pullover hat
- any other hat of preference
- small bottle of gun solvent
- personal gear (towel, toothbrush, etc.)
- soft rifle or bow case

### Additional Information:

Total charter plane luggage weight is not to exceed 75 lbs. Any items not needed may be left in our seure buliding in Whitehorse. Also bring along a good camera and plenty of film. A good set of binoculars is advisable, and a good hunting knife will come in handy on many occasions. Orange clothing is not required in the Yukon.
